Parents' Evenings are scheduled for early in the new term, beginning on Wednesday 19 April with Grade 12. These evenings run 17:30-19:00 and take place in the school hall.

As I mentioned, we have several tours taking place over the holiday period. 1st team Hockey play in Potchefstroom and Johannesburg, 1st Rugby join them in Johannesburg at KES, and U14, U15 and U16 rugby boys also tour to Gauteng. There are also other festivals for Hockey teams. Locally we host our own U15 Rugby Festival from tomorrow evening, and the traditional U14 Ken Florens Hockey Festival will follow that. I extend my thanks in advance to all boys, parents and staff who will give of their time to represent our school during the holiday period.

Her journey her seen her take on any number of roles, including Subject Head and Grade Tutor, and any boy who has been fortunate enough to be taught by her will testify to her dedication and commitment, as well as her ability to inspire. She leaves with our best wishes for the future, and can do so being proud of what she has brought to the school.

Mr East has been assisting the Sports department for the last year or so, and also leaves our full time employ. As an Old Boy he has brought passion to his tasks, and has contributed in a number of areas. We thank him sincerely for his hard work.

Grant Bashford has been our Director of Rugby since late 2013, and leaves this position after the KES Easter Festival in Johannesburg. He does this to take up an extremely exciting opportunity in Japan, where he will become the Head Coach of a franchise in the Japanese league. However the quality of the Northwood side still shone through and by the end of the match they ran out 4-0 winners, with a hat-trick from Cade Leaity as well. On Saturday the 1st XI played a solid Westville team on Saturday in what was set to be a close encounter. It was Westville who had the first chance of the game however the rest of the half was played predominantly between the 25 yard lines. It was however Westville who opened their account from a well-directed flick from a PC. Westville then doubled their lead from an error in midfield which saw a WBHS striker unmarked in the D to tap home the final pass. The score remained 2-0 at the break to the visitors. The 2nd half saw a strange affair of events unfold where Northwood dominated both possession and territory that lead to an early goal from Jordan Edy's backhand shot. However repeated crucial mistakes and poor finishing allowed WBHS to capitalise on further mistakes from Northwood and ran in another 3 second half goals to leave the score 5-1 come the final whistle.
