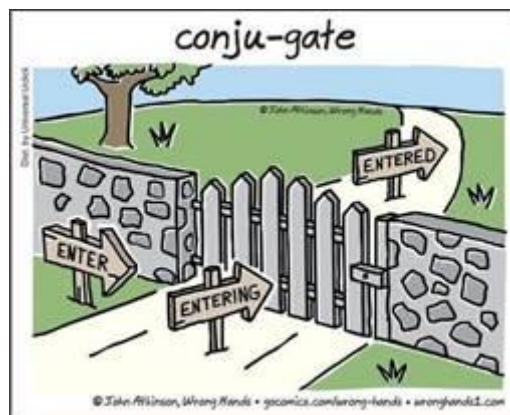

From the Headmaster

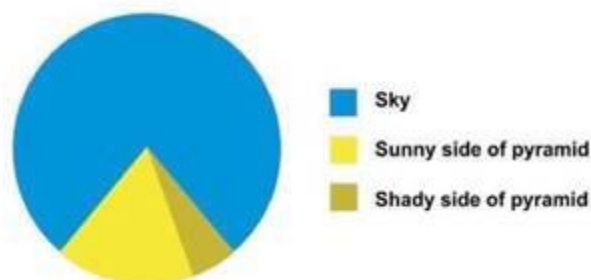
