PAIN IN THE NECK!

National Physiotherapy Back Week is coming up in September and, once again, as physiotherapists, we are trying to raise awareness about healthy spines.

There is a new neck pain arising that comes about from our addiction to 21st century devices – laptops, tablets, smart phones.

Our heads are in a forward position, our shoulders hunched or rounded more and more often.

Did you know that when your head is bent forward looking down at your cell phone the force going through our neck is 27kg!!!

Long tem issues can lead to a permanent change in your neck bone alignment. Apart from looking unattractive, there is serious strain being put on your ligaments, muscles, discs and joints.

Some very simple steps to follow

- Your screen laptop, PC, tablet should be as close to eye level as possible.
- Make sure that your shoulders are down and squeezed to the back.
- Always have your PC, tablet, laptop on a hard surface like a table or desk.
- Lift your phone UP to eye level.
- Set a reminder on your phone or computer to check how your posture is.
- PILLOWS are so important, if you are waking up with neck pain review your pillow height.
- Make sure your chin is not poking forward, tuck it in a little.

Reduce the strain and pain on your neck, the results are worth it.
