This week we have launched an anonymous incident reporting app through "The Guardian". We are one of the first schools in the country to roll this out fully, and request you support and feedback as it progresses.

The app is a free download, and boys are being asked to this during grade assemblies being held over the coming days. The pupose of the app – which can also be downloaded by parents –



is to allow us to become better informed about incidents which might otherwise go unreported. The school receives anonymous reports via the app, and the recipients on the staff (designated and trained personnel, always more than one person will receive the same report) will be able to provide feedback without knowing the identity of the reporter. Please see the link below for more information. This is a progressive move, and it can only help in guiding us regarding the wellbeing of our boys.
