Exams – they don't have to be a pain in the neck.

Term two is here and it means time for some serious studying. Tests, projects and exams are about to be launched upon the school pupils. Parents may find this time stressful too.

Studying can be hard at the best of times but when one's posture, ergonomics and body position are compromised, pain can creep in.

Sitting for long periods of time, feeling stressed and anxious, sleeping less and poor eating habits can all contribute to increased neck, back and shoulder pain.

At this time headaches can begin to creep in or get worse. But there are a few useful tips that may ease the bodily stress at this time:-

- When studying ensure that you are sitting at a desk or table, do NOT sit and study on the floor or your bed.
- Take regular breaks and have a walk, even if around the house. AVOID sitting in one position for too long.
- Your back should be supported by your chair and your elbows, arms resting on the desk.
- Work in good light, this will prevent you from leaning forward and straining your eyes and back.
- Make sure both feet are on the floor and not tucked under you, this keeps the back and hips straight and prevents strain around the knee area.
- If your back is aching and not relieved but some movement and gentle stretches, apply some heat to relax the muscles.

Before the Panado is reached for, try some of the above tips. If muscle spasm, pain and or headaches continue please book a session at the physiotherapist. Easing sore muscles, posture advice and exercises may go a long way to helping reduce exam stress and tension.

Remember that some light exercise will get the blood flowing and oxygen levels up. Keep moving.
