From the Headmaster

Dear Parents

I write this week's Northwood News from beautiful Cape Town, while attending the Heads of Boys' Schools annual conference.

There are so many important pieces of policy, legislation and protocols that school management must adhere to that have been discussed – all that we, as a school, are well equipped to deal with. But by far the most vibrant discussions are around the skills we need to teach our boys as we move into and through the fourth industrial revolution.

The Fourth Industrial Revolution can be described as the advent of "cyber-physical systems" involving entirely new capabilities for people and machines. While these capabilities are reliant on the technologies and infrastructure of the Third Industrial Revolution, the Fourth Industrial Revolution represents entirely new ways in which technology becomes embedded within societies and even our human bodies. Examples include genome editing, new forms of machine intelligence, breakthrough materials and approaches to governance that rely on cryptographic methods such as the blockchain.

This revolution clearly places different demands on us, and therefor requires us to adapt the way we teach, implement the curriculum and asses our boys, all with the aim of developing skills; including s elf-awareness, resilience, critical thinking, collaboration and emotional intelligence – among others.

Parents, I want to ensure you that we are far better placed than our counterparts, in other boys or independent schools, to make sure we deal with the responsibility of the expectations laid out earlier.

The implementation of advanced mathematics, in grade 8 and 9, design in grade 10, cross curricular assessment planning, project based learning and a greater focus on creating entrepreneurial and creative opportunities are all happening in 2019 and as such, we are extremely well positioned to add immense value to the learning of our boys.

In terms of the prefect and boarding prefect announcement that happened on Tuesday, I would like to extend a word of congratulations to each of these boys and their parents. The boys have all taken pledges that stipulate that their main responsibility is to serve their peers, and therefore these positions come with great expectation and responsibility. I certainly look forward to seeing how they take to their different tasks.
