### From the Headmaster

Dear Parents

This week we opened the application process for our prospective grade 8's of 2020. It is wonderful to see how many forms has been collected and how keen boys are to join Northwood. In terms of our admissions for 2019, I can confirm that this process is now complete and we are certainly very happy with the number, and more importantly the quality of the boys who will be joining us as squires.

Ultimately, the number of boys we have accepted into grade 8 next year is confirmed at 250 boys. This may seem like a big number, but is in keeping with the number of boys we accepted in 2017 and 2018. With the support of the governing body, and by extension of fee-paying parents, we employ an additional 40 staff to maintain the average class size of 25 boys per class.

This allows us to make good on our promise of treating every boy as significant and to make sure we pay attention to the individual needs of all our boys.

Talking about school fees, I encourage parents to make sure your accounts are paid up to date, as we move

towards the end of the year. The school fee letter for 2019 and information regarding early settlement discounts are available on the D6 communicator.

In terms of the exam period, I encourage parents to remain calm, encouraging and supportive of the boys as they deal with the challenges that the various papers bring. Your love and support means a lot to them during this period, so please keep providing the care you are already giving so abundantly.

And when your boy seems overly stressed or anxious, here is a poem about exams you can share with them. Don't stress about this exam because the hype will kill you faster than the raw shock of receiving the test. The panic will gnaw at you for days and intensify over hours as you fret and read until your mind cannot process any more. So try to breathe and put the notes down
