Dear Parents

As we complete week two of term 1, please note some important points in terms of the school's operations.

- Please ensure your boy arrives at school on time. Our registration classes are now later in the day, so lessons start at 7.40. If boys are late, they will miss out on valuable teaching time.
- The two test lessons now run on a Tuesday and Thursday before break if your son is absent on those test days you will be contacted by the grade tutor to check on the whereabouts of your boy. If he is legitimately ill, and misses the formal scheduled test, please provide a doctor's note on the day of his return to school. For your convenience, the plan of assessment for the term is loaded on the D6 communicator. Please familiarise yourself with the important dates on the academic calendar.
- A full set of support/extra lessons will be run again this year.
- In mathematics in grade 8 and 9 these lessons have been specifically created within the school day, so all the boys will have two extra lessons. The math department therefore will not run additional classes in those grades after school.
- The homework centres on upper and lower campus will be fully operational from next week. Teachers are on duty to assist and guide your son with extra help and support, so please encourage your son to use the facility. In some cases, subject teachers may refer boys to the centres to complete addition work in order to assist them with managing a specific section of work. Attendance is then compulsory. - Grade 12 parents please note that should your son fail to hand in a portfolio task on the day of submission, you will be contacted and your son will have to complete the task during academic detention the next day. This detention will take preference and your son will not be allowed to attend sports practices on the detention day.
- Summer uniforms are now in use, but as per tradition boys must wear their blazers and ties for assembly on Monday.
- Please be aware that there is, and will be, some smaller construction projects that may cause some inconvenience to the parents and the boys throughout term one. The ladies bathroom at the Jubilee Room and the boy's bathroom on the upper campus are being overhauled which is much needed. A special thank you to our governing body for supporting this venture.

PHYSIOTHERAPY AFTER SURGERY

Did you know that physiotherapists can play an instrumental role in helping one recover from many different types of surgery?

So often once a person has had surgery it is believed that they are healed and well on the road to recovery. But often there is post -surgical pain, swelling, restricted range of movement and loss of strength.

Physiotherapists are trained to assess post- surgical cases and have been trained to follow the protocols that have been put in place to aid full recovery.

The normal procedure following most surgery is to receive physiotherapy whilst in hospital. These exercises are usually basic circulatory and muscle activation based exercises. It is typical that most surgeons expect these to be done for 2 weeks after an operation.

After the doctor's follow up appointment, usually after 2 weeks, then additional physiotherapy based healing and rehabilitation can continue.

This can involve more advanced strength and range of motion exercises, anti -inflammatory assistance and soft tissue treatment.

From shoulders to elbows, knees, backs and hips, even ankles physiotherapy after surgery can be of great benefit to you.

Keep this in mind after any surgery and ask your surgeon if and when you can start some treatment.
