



#### From the Headmaster

#### MR P P VILJOEN

**Dear Parents** 

On Tuesday afternoon I attended the memorial service of the late Roshni Moonsamy, the headmistress at Northlands Girls High who so tragically died in a car accident two weeks ago.

Occasions like these are hard to attend as one's heart is always aching, and one's mind is filled with thoughts of regret and often also drifts to thoughts of how easily life can end.

Everything I know of Ms Moonsamy was good – a woman of integrity, honesty, caring, kind, passionate, steadfast in her belief that doing the right supersedes all else. Ms Moonsamy leaves a legacy that only a person in education can leave - thousands of stories from her beloved Northlands Girls and staff of how she influenced their lives. A legacy of how things should be done, of what passion for a school and its pupils and staff really looks like, and a legacy within the DOE of excellence and accuracy in whatever she did.

The reason I write about Ms Moonsamy is not only because she was a headmistress, an integral part of our community, a much loved figure or a really good person, but because she was a teacher.

Teachers sacrifice everything for the children in their classes – they are people who love, care, educate, counsel, coach and always make time for others. Yet they are so easily criticized, blamed or held accountable for the actions of others. Yet they keep coming back to class, the sports field or the stage day after day, because they are by nature there to serve the children in front of them.

Teachers are of course also people and people make mistakes, yet we don't like to grant them the luxury of forgiving them. The Northwood staff, just like Ms Moonsamy, give their hearts and souls to your boys, parents – when next you want to blame them or fight with them, please take a moment to appreciate all they do for the boys they teach. They chose the profession because they love children and people and I for one, believe that it is something we should all cherish.

Thank you to all of the parents who are opening their homes to the visiting boys from Parktown over the weekend. I am so very grateful to all of you for your efforts and what is sure to be great hospitality.

Last, but by no means least, we would like to say thank you to all our mothers. Our own, the boys', the staffs' those mothers on the staff and the surrogate mothers to all our boys at school. Your maternal love and strength is so often what carries us through the tough times and your love and caring is a constant that we can depend upon in our lives. We love and appreciate

you more than we can say.

#### **CTU OPEN DAY**



This weekend is not a compulsory attendance fixture but we still welcome all support.


