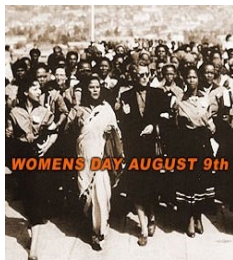
SIVEST BURSARY SCHEME 2020
