As you may be aware, Northwood School is part of the International Boys School's Coalition, a group of international boys' schools who share a similar ethos and value system.

I am writing to request your participation in an important survey being conducted by the IBSC.

Northwood is one of more than twenty prominent boys' schools in South Africa involved in a research project on excellence in boys' education. The project will bring many benefits to our school, as well as to the larger network of boys' schools in South Africa and abroad.
