Dear Parents

Hardly a day goes by that I am not left astounded by our boys' ability, achievements, creativity, honesty or inventiveness. On Monday I was once again reminded what it means to be brave as Chad Barber, grade 12, addressed our boys on bullying.

I have shared his incredibly powerful words with you below:

"Good morning school

If I could just take a few moments of your time to speak to you about a rather concerning topic. The world is a place full of evil and that evil spreads, so many things bring about cruel turnings in the world. War, death, hate, jealousy and so many other things happen but let's focus on the one that is so common that we often overlook it: BULLYING!

People think that bullying is tough, it is not tough, you want to know what is tough?

Go up to the people that tease you and say "Please stop". That's tough.

What number of suicides have to take place before society realizes that bullying kills people?

How do we get it through to people that pulling someone down won't make you reach the top? Bullying is not funny nor is it a game.

I myself have been a victim of name calling and body shaming to name a few. It's not normal like most people think. We assume it will help in building the character of a child — this is not true. Instead it breaks the child's confidence along with his heart and soul.

I often kept quiet and never reached out to anyone for guidance when I was going through this tough time in my life and this has always been my biggest regret as I bottled up my emotions and eventually burst out in an irrational manner. That is why I am speaking to you this morning as we are all now in high school. A high school where all the staff and our brothers will have our backs no matter what.

We, as a school community, need to be that support network for these pupils who can't speak for themselves as I once was, we need to be the change. Bullying happens way more than it should but you always have the power to make a ...
