From the Headmaster's Desk

Dear Parents

As we edge closer to the return to full capacity on Monday, I need to highlight how important it is for boys and parents to follow procedures in terms of the management of the Covid 19 protocols.

As the number of students on our campus increases, we all have a bigger responsibility than before. We need to respect each other's safety by being transparent in answering the Covid Screening questions, take a conservative approach in allowing our children to attend school if they have flu like symptoms or are feeling unwell.

Please also be aware that from Monday our grade 8 and 9 boys are to be dropped off at the entrance to Lower Campus – we have set up screening points for them there which will prevent congestion and delays at our Upper Campus drop off point.

In terms of our boys' appearance and dress, please assist us in ensuring that your son is impeccable. Presenting well in terms of uniform and appearance is an important part of ensuring our boys get back into the habits and procedures that extend to a "return to normal", so let's ensure that we work together to meet expectations.

I am pleased to report that our 2021 proposed budget and accompanying resolutions, were passed by our parent body on Monday evening. The school fee letter will be published later today, but I am delighted that the school fees for 2021 have been increased by only a R130 a month – that equates to an increase of only 2,8%, an adjustment that I am sure comes as a great relief to our parents. A very big thank you to our Finance Committee and Mr Mutch and his team, for working so hard to make this possible. Thank you too, to those parents who are continuing to contribute to their 2020 fees – as mentioned, you are all contributing towards the protection of our staff, service providers and suppliers' livelihoods and as such I am incredibly grateful to all of you.
