I am just so incredibly grateful for all that has been bestowed upon us this week. Long may the blessings continue.

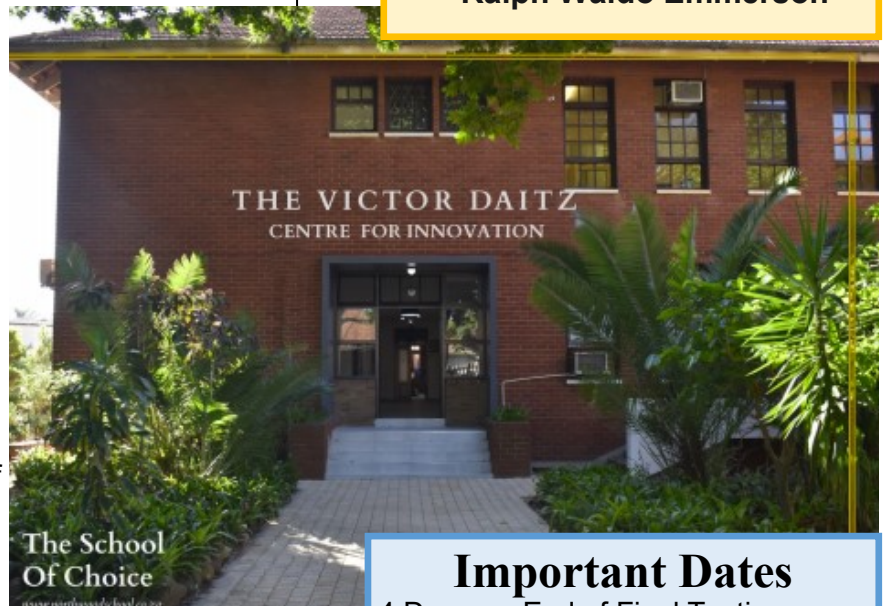
