# From the Headmaster's Desk

#### Dear Parents

During the course of this week we have engaged with further infrastructure upgrades to our facilities. I do apologize for any inconvenience you may experience during this time but ultimately, these changes benefit our boys and broader parent community. If all goes according to plan, the renovations should be completed by the 7<sup>th</sup> of April.

I have also been approached by a number of parents enquiring about the return to competitive sport. The information I have is that the final draft, in relation to school sport and cultural activities, is currently being finalized by the DOE and should be published on the 15<sup>th</sup> of March. As soon as we have final confirmation of the way forward, I will share this with you immediately.

In terms of our school's capacity, it is important for our community to note that we have received official documentation from the DOE declaring the school full. This is a meaningful and positive result for our school as it means we can manage all aspects of the school with far greater control and accuracy and we now have full control over our class sizes. This does, however, mean that the 2022 learner intake in grade 8 will be limited to the number of boys leaving the school, at the end of the year. This will mean that, in area boys may very well not find placement at Northwood.

A reminder too, that SGB parent elections take place on Monday evening as per the notices placed on our communication platform. Please ensure you bring along proof of identification to be eligible to cast your vote.
